

NOTICE OF SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a special municipal election will be held in the City of Hoover in the State of Alabama on **Tuesday, the 27th day of April, 2010**, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Central Time, at which there will be submitted to the qualified electors of the said City, for their determination by ballot, the following proposition:

Shall the 24 mills of the ad valorem tax presently being levied in the City of Hoover, Alabama, pursuant to the general provisions of the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama (which 24 mills are for public school purposes), on each dollar of taxable property in the City for each consecutive tax year of the City until and including the tax year for which municipal taxes become due and payable on October 1, 2027, continue to be levied annually, commencing with the tax year for which municipal taxes become due and payable on October 1, 2028, and for the 18 consecutive years next succeeding thereafter, in continuation of the tax approved at an election held in the City on May 12, 1998?
